

# GETTING TO THE MORNINGTON PENINSULA

## DRIVE, TRAIN, FLY OR FERRY

Access is so, so simple for Melbourne, Victorian, interstate and overseas delegates.

## BY ROAD

An easy drive of less than an hour, you can take a quick exit from the city on EastLink or the M1, then Peninsula Link with not a traffic light in sight.

## BY TRAIN

Venues such as the Frankston Arts Centre and nearby accommodation are easily reached by metropolitan trains from Melbourne. Services run every 15 minutes (Monday to Saturday) and 20 minutes on Sunday. Journey time: one hour.

## BY AIR

From Melbourne International Airport, take City Link, then EastLink and Peninsula Link. You'll be here in just 90 minutes.

## BY SEA

The easy option from western Victoria: Queenscliff-Sorrento vehicle and passenger ferries. On the hour every hour, with a scenic 40-minute trip including a peek at the celebrated multi-million dollar mansions on Portsea's cliffs.
